To equip a dedicated minor operations room

This will speed up the treatment of significant injuries that need the care and attention of a plastic surgeon where stitches are needed. The patient can be treated immediately in the Plastics department, rather than waiting in A & E or for time in a general operating theatre, which could involve another visit to the hospital.

To speed the diagnosis and treatment of skin cancer

By providing specialist probes for lymph nodes, doctors can identify the precise location of skin cancer (melanoma) in a patient, without further surgical intervention. Further treatment, including radiotherapy and trials with new treatments, can then be targeted at the cancer hot spots.

People in your family could be at risk from injury or illness which severely damages their skin

10% of people seen in an A & E department will have a serious injury to their skin.

Skin cancer is the most common type of cancer and accounts for half of all new cancers.
